

# **Code of Conduct – Participants**

By registering for this event, I confirm that I have read, understood and agree to comply with this Code of Conduct.

## **1. General Principles**

This event aims to provide a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability, body size, physical appearance, ethnicity, nationality, religion. Harassment, discrimination, bullying and any form of non-consensual physical or verbal conduct will not be tolerated.

## **2. Consent and Boundaries**

Everyone has the right to decline a dance or any physical contact, at any time and without needing to justify the decision. This must be accepted gracefully. Partner work involving closer contact, dips, lifts, aerials or similar movements may only take place with the clear, informed consent of both partners, and must respect each person's stated limits. Unwanted comments, contact or attention of a sexual nature are strictly prohibited.

## **3. Respect for Others**

Participants are expected to treat teachers, organizers, staff, volunteers, DJs, musicians and fellow participants with courtesy and respect at all times, on and off the dance floor.

## **4. Alcohol and Substances**

Participants are welcome to enjoy the social side of the event responsibly. Consuming alcohol or other substances to the point of impairing judgment, safety or the comfort of others is not acceptable.

## **5. Health and Safety**

Participants confirm that they are in adequate health to take part in the classes and social dancing. Please inform the organizers of any injury or condition that may affect your ability to dance safely, and communicate relevant limitations to your dance partners.

## **6. Photography and Media**

Photos and videos may be taken during the event for the organizer's own non-commercial promotional purposes (e.g. website, social media, future event promotion). Participants who do not wish to be photographed or filmed may notify the organizers in advance, and every reasonable effort will be made to respect this.

## **7. Reporting and Enforcement**

Anyone who experiences or witnesses a breach of this Code of Conduct is encouraged to report it to the organizers as soon as possible. Reports will be handled with discretion. The organizers may take any action deemed appropriate, including a warning, temporary exclusion, or permanent removal from the event without refund, in cases of serious or repeated violations. Serious incidents (e.g. involving potential criminal conduct) may be referred to the competent authorities.

## **8. Acceptance**

Registration for the event constitutes acceptance of this Code of Conduct. Continued participation is conditional on compliance with it.
